The Neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) at OMNI RK is the best in Andhra Pradesh in terms of design, medical infrastructure, equipment and quality of care. This 30 bedded NICU has world-class warmers, ventilators, phototherapy units and other equipment. It has separate cubicles for inborn, out born and septic babies. What sets the NICU apart is the fact that it offers facilities which very few healthcare centres in India are equipped with.

Dr K . Seshagiri, who has done his DM Neonatology from the prestigious PGIMER, Chandigarh, is the first Neonatologist of Visakhapatnam and has more than 10 years of post DM experience and is Chief Neonatologist of our Department of Neonatology. Survival rates in our NICU are more than 90% because of strict asepsis protocols by trained Nurses, good infrastructure and dedicated registrars of our department.

Especially for gynecologists who are planning premature deliveries because of maternal and fetal indications and high risk cases, they can shift the mothers to our hospital admit under their care and utilize our facilities (in utero transfer), because it is very difficult to shift the sick preterm babies safely.

With more than 10 years of post Mch experience, whose area of interest is laparoscopic surgeries. He has many firsts in newborn laparoscopic surgeries to his credit in Visakhapatnam like Tracheo Esophageal Fistula, and Diaphragmatic Hernia surgery by laparoscopy. Our hospital has got Laminar Flow Operation theatres, Dragger Anesthesia work stations, complete laparoscopic equipment required for newborn and paediatric surgery.
